I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE CURRICULUM:(38-39 credits)

Area A: Communications (9 credits)

ENG 101 (3)* [C1 900]	Composition I (<i>Prereq. ENG 099 with a grade of C or better or qualifying score on English Placement Test</i>)
ENG 102 (3)* [C1 901]	Composition II (<i>Prereq. ENG 101 with C or better</i>)
COMM 101 (3) [C2 900]	Principles of Communication [was SPCH 101]

**Must have a "C" or better in ENG 101 & 102 to receive credit for the PSC degree.*

Area B: Humanities and Fine Arts (9 credits)

Select three courses with at least one course selected from the literature area and one course from the fine arts area. Refer to the Associate in Arts Degree Worksheet for a listing of approved course choices.

Humanities Course (3)	HUMAN 101 – Comparative Religions (recommended for cross cultural)
Fine Arts Course (3)	ART 131 – Survey of Non-Western Art (recommended for cross cultural)
ENG 211 or 212 (3)	American Literature I or II

Area C: Mathematics (3-4 credits)

MATH 115 (3) [M1 902] General Education Statistics (*Prereq. MATH 095 & 096 with C or better OR MATH 095 and high school geometry, both with C or better OR qualifying score on the Math Placement Test*)

OR

MATH 157 (4) [M1 900-B] Calculus for Business & Social Science (*Prereq. MATH 151 with C or better or qualifying score on Math Placement Test*)

Area D: Physical and Life Sciences (8 credits)

Select one life science course and one physical science course. **Both** courses must have a lab component. Refer to the Associate in Arts Degree Worksheet, Area D, for a listing of approved course choices.

Physical Science Course (4) Recommend CHEM 105, PHYSC 111, or PHYSI 101
