Transfer Agreement between Daley College AA degree (elementary education concentration) and Trinity Christian College Adult Studies BA Education and/or teacher certification (secondary)

Required courses towards secondary certification:

- I. Communications** (9 credits for AA degree)*
- English 101 – Composition I (3)
 - English 102 – Composition II (3)
 - Speech 101 – Fundamentals of Speech Comm. (3)
- II. Humanities/Fine Arts** (9 credits for AA degree)*
- Literature 110 – Introduction to Literature (3)
 - IAI approved Humanities and Fine Arts (6)
- III. Mathematics** (4 credits for AA degree)*
- IAI Approved Math Course – must be above pre-calculus (4)
Recommend Math 118 – General Education Math
- IV. Life / Physical Sciences** – must have labs (7 credits for AA degree)*
- Biology 114, 115, 121, 122, 200, 226, or 227 (4-5)
Recommend Biology 114 – General Education Biology
 - IAI approved Physical Science with lab – not Geology 201 (4-5)
Recommend Chemistry 121 OR Physical Science 112
- V. Social Sciences** (9 credits for AA degree)*
- History 111 – American People to 1865 (3)
OR History 112 American People since 1865
 - History 141 – The History of World Civilization to 1500 (3)
OR History 142 – The History of World Civilization from 1500
 - Psychology 214 – Adolescent Psychology (3)
- VI. Cross Cultural Elective** (6 hours) (6)
- Course should provide insights to societal structures and development of cultures that are fundamentally non-western. One semester of a modern foreign language will also fulfill requirement.
