- II. Behavioral/Social Sciences** (9 credits for AA degree)*
 - HIST 105 – American History to 1865 (3)
OR HIST 106 – American History from 1865
 - PSY 211 – Adolescent Psychology (3)
OR PSY 215 – Life Span: A Survey of Human Development
Recommend PSY 215
 - IAI Approved Behavioral/Social Science (3)

- III. Mathematics** (4 credits for AA degree)*
 - IAI approved Mathematics Course (4)

- IV. Physical / Life Sciences** with labs (7 credits for AA degree)*
 - Life Science – BIO 102, 110 (4)
 - Physical Science - CHM 105, PHS 103, PHY 101 (4)

- V. Humanities/Fine Arts** (9 credits for AA degree)*
 - ENG 211 – Introduction to Literature (3)
 - HIS 103 – Early Western Civilization (3)
OR HIS 104 – Modern Western Civilization

- VI. Health and Physical Fitness** (2 credits for AA degree)*

- VII. Cross Cultural Elective** (6 hours) (6)
 - Course should provide insights to societal structures and development of cultures that are fundamentally non-western. Two semesters of a modern foreign language will also fulfill requirement.

- Program begins 3 times a year: January, June, September at our Palos Heights campus
- At the Addison center, the program begins in January and September only
