Transfer Agreement between Moraine Valley AA degree (general) and Trinity Christian College Adult Studies BA Education and/or teacher certification (secondary)

Required courses towards secondary certification:

- I. Communications** (9 credits for AA degree)*
 - COM 101 – Composition I (3)
 - COM 102 – Composition II (3)
 - COM 103 – Speech Fundamentals (3)

- II. Mathematics** (3 credits for AA degree)*
 - MTH 120, 139, 143, 145, 150, 151, 152, 212 (3)
Recommend MTH 120 (must be above intermediate algebra)

- III. Life / Physical Sciences** (8 credits for AA degree)*
 - IAI approved Life Science with lab (4)
Recommend BIO 111 – General Biology
 - CHEM 111, 131 - OR - (4)
PHS 101 – Physical Science - OR -
PHYS 106 and 107 - Fundamentals of Physics w/ lab

- IV. Humanities/Fine Arts** (9 credits for AA degree)*
 - Lit 213, 214, 215, 216, 219, 220, 221, 223, 224, 226 (3)
 - IAI approved Fine Arts (3)
 - Additional Elective from Humanities/Fine Arts (3)

- V. Social Sciences** (9 credits for AA degree)*
 - HIS 101 or 102 - Western Civilization I & II - AND - (3)
HIS 201 or 202 - American History I & II (3)
 - PSY 104, 106 - Lifespan/Adolescent Psychology (3)
Recommend PSY 104 – Lifespan Development

- VI. Cross Cultural Elective** (6 hours) (6)
 - Course should provide insights to societal structures and development of cultures that are fundamentally non-western. One semester of a modern foreign language will also fulfill requirement.
NOTE: 3 hours met with A.A. or A.S. degree

 - IAI approved courses
