EDUCATION: pre-Elementary Education Majors

(Associate in Arts Degree)

I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE (43 credits)

Area A: Communications (9 credits)

ENG 101 (3) [C1 900]* Composition I (*Prereq. ENG099 with C or better or qualifying score on English Placement Test*)

ENG 102 (3) [C1 901R]* Composition II (*Prereq. ENG101 with C or better*)

COMM 101 (3) [C2 900] Principles of Communication (3)

*Must have "C" or better in ENG 101 & 102 to receive credit for the degree.

Area B: Humanities and Fine Arts (9 credits)

Select three courses with at least one course selected from the humanities area and one course from the fine arts area. Refer to the Associate in Arts Degree Worksheet, Area B, for a listing of approved course choices.

Humanities Course (3) Select any Area B humanities elective

Fine Arts Course (3) (*Recommend ART 131 – Survey of Non-Western Art*)

MATH 200 (4) Mathematics for Elementary Teaching I (*Prereq. MATH 095 & 096 with C or better OR MATH 095 and high school geometry, both with C or better OR qualifying score on Math Placement Test.*)

MATH 206 (4) [M1 903] Mathematics for Elementary Teaching II (*Prereq. MATH 200 with C or better*)

(Note: Must complete both MATH 200 & 206 to receive this degree)

Area D: Physical and Life Sciences (8 credits)

BIOL 100 (4) General Education Biology

PHYS 111 (4) Physical Science

Area E: Social and Behavioral Sciences (9 credits)

HIST 201 (3) [S2 900] OR HIST 202 [S2 901] U.S. History

POLSC 140 (3) [S5 900] Introduction to U.S. Government & Politics

HIST 151 (3) OR HIST 152 History of Western Civilization

II. ELECTIVES (19 hours)

MATH 100 or higher (3) Additional Math Course

PHYS 112 (4) Earth Science

OR GEOL 101 or 102 Physical / Historical Geology

ENG 220 or ED 220 (3) Children's Literature

GEOG 101 (3) Cultural Geography

ED 101 (3) Child Growth & Development

OR PSYCH 102 (3) Human Growth & Development: Lifespan
(*Prereq. PSYCH 101*)

Cross Cultural Elective (3) (*Met with A.A. or A.S. degree*)

Course should provide insights to societal structures and development of cultures that are fundamentally non-western. One semester of a modern foreign language will also fulfill requirement.

III. TOTAL CREDIT REQUIRED FOR ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE: 62 credits

NOTE: A **MINOR** is required for elementary certification. Minimum 18 semester hours in one subject area. Minimum 9 semester hours must be at 200 level or above.
