Transfer Agreement between College of DuPage AA degree (general) and Trinity Christian College Adult Studies BA Education and/or teacher certification (secondary)

Required courses towards secondary certification:

AT COD YOU TAKE:

- I. Communications** (9 credits for AA degree)*
 - English 1101 – English Composition I (3)
 - English 1102 – English Composition II (3)
 - Speech 1100 – Fundamentals of Speech Communication (3)

- II. Physical / Life Sciences** (7-10 credits for AA degree)*
 - Chemistry 1211 or 1551 – General Chemistry / Principles of Chemistry (4-5)
OR Physics 1100 or 1201 – Physics / General Physics I
 - Any Life Science course for AA with lab (4-5)

- III. Mathematics** (3-5 credits for AA degree)*
 - 1000 level or higher IAI approved (not Math 1428) (3-5)
Recommend Math 1218 – General Education Mathematics

- IV. Humanities/Fine Arts** (9 credits for AA degree)*
 - English Literature 1130 – Introduction to Literature (3)
 - History 1110 – Western Civilization I (3)
OR History 1120 – Western Civilization II
 - IAI approved Fine Arts (for AA) (3)

- V. Social Sciences** (9 credits for AA degree)*
 - History 1130 – History of the US to 1865 (3)
OR History 1140 – History of the US since 1865
 - Psychology 2233 or 2237 – Adolescence / Lifespan (3)
Recommend Psychology 2237 – Lifespan Development
 - Select any IAI approved social science course (3)

- VI. Cross Cultural Elective** (6 hours) (6)
 - Course should provide insights to societal structures and development of cultures that are fundamentally non-western.
NOTE: 3 hours met with A.A. or A.S. degree
*Recommend one of the following: Anthropology 1100 or 1130 **OR** History 2205, 2210, 2215, 2220, 2225, 2230, or 2240 **OR** one semester of a foreign language*

- VII. Electives:** Please contact a Trinity Advisor for recommended courses
 - IAI approved courses

- VIII. TOTAL CREDIT REQUIRED FOR AA OR AS DEGREE:** 64 credits
 * **Indicates the minimum credit hours needed for an Associate in Arts degree at COD for students pursuing this degree.**
