- VI. Health and Physical Fitness** (2 credits for AA degree)\*
  - IAI approved Health and Physical Fitness (2)
  
- VII. Cross Cultural Elective** (6 hours) (6)
  - Course should provide insights to societal structures and development of cultures that are fundamentally non-western. Two semesters of a modern foreign language will also fulfill requirement.  
*NOTE: 3 hours met with A.A. or A.S. degree*  
*Recommend the following to complete requirement:*

- Program begins 3 times a year: January, June, September at our Palos Heights campus
- At the Addison center, the program begins in January and September only
